### **ATHERSTONE 1828/1829**

A neat market town in the parish of *Mancetter*, hundred of Hemlingford. 107 miles from *London*, 24 from *Warwick*, 20 from *Birmingham*, 14 from *Coventry* and 5 from *Nuneaton*. Remarkable in history for being the place where the Earl of **Richmond** and his nobles held a council the night before the battle of *Bosworth Field*.

The town stands on the Watling Street of the Romans and consists chiefly of one street, a full mile in length, tolerably well built with a market square and house, the latter is a good erection on pillars over which is an assembly room.

The situation of this town is very delightful, being sheltered by a range of wood clad hills at the back, the front presenting a beautiful and extensive prospect.

The River Anker glides about a mile from the town. The chief manufactures of the town are hats, soldier's caps and ribbons. The place for divine worship is St Mary's church. There is a meetinghouse for both Independents and Unitarians. Market day is Tuesday.
